

ICD-10-PCS A&P Module: Head and Facial bones, upper and lower bone (0N-0Q) and Upper joints, lowers joints (0R-0S)

Course Description

The ICD-10-PCS Module: Head and facial bones, upper & lower bones (0N-0Q) & Upper joints, lower joints (0R-0S), is a combined module designed to enhance coding professionals' knowledge in anatomy, physiology, and pathophysiology terminology for conditions related to medical and surgical procedures for head and facial bones, upper & lower bones and upper & lower joints. It also reviews the ICD-10-PCS codes (0N-0S) as it relates to these conditions. This module concludes with a 20-question final self-assessment test to assess your practical knowledge of the skills reviewed.

Learning Objectives

- Discuss the structure of ICD-10-PCS including the meanings of the 7 characters
- Explain why mastery of root operations is crucial for "building" a correct code
- Define and be able to apply the four ICD-10-PCS procedural approaches relevant to bone and joint procedures
- Explain the process of referencing a code in the alphabetic index and completing it with a table
- Know the anatomy of the head and facial bones, the upper and lower bones, and the upper and lower joints
- Understand the objective of the following procedures and be able to code them:
 - Percutaneous Anterior column cervical spinal fusion C5-7 open, anterior approach, with interbody fusion device
 - Posterior spinal fusion of the posterior column at L2-L4 levels with BAK cage interbody fusion device, open
 - Insertion of X-Stop (interspinous process device) into lumbar vertebral joint, percutanous approach
 - · Percutaneous lumbar vertebroplasty
 - Percutaneous kyphoplasty of lumbar spine
 - Percutaneous kyphoplasty of L2 with bone biopsy
 - Insertion of cervical vertebral disc prosthesis
 - Open excision of herniated lumbosacral intervertebral disc
 - Right Total Hip Replacement (press-fit; metal on poly)
 - Right hip hemiarthroplasty (metal Zimmer LDFX cemented monopolar) to treat femoral neck fracture
 - Removal of right THR due to infection with spacer insertion
 - · Open exchange of liner in right femoral component on previous hip replacement
 - Revision THR due to dislocation of prosthetic joint



- Conversion of a previous right hip hemiarthroplasty to a total metal-on-poly right hip replacement
- Left total knee replacement
- Right total shoulder replacement
- Right reverse total shoulder replacement
- Closed reduction with percutaneous internal fixation of displaced left intertrochanteric femoral fracture
- ORIF traumatic tibia shaft, right
- Open fracture reduction, displaced fracture of right distal humerus
- ORIF left index finger
- Removal of external fixator, left humeral head fracture
- Interphalangeal fusion of right great toe, percutaneous pin fixation
- Open Biopsy of left scapula for diagnosis of possible Ewing's Sarcoma
- Arthroscopic partial medial meniscectomy for treatment of torn meniscus, medial, bucket handle
- Amputation at the left elbow level
- Right ankle joint amputation

Because this is a combined module, it has more content and is longer than the other modules.
