

Introduction to ICD-10 CM

Course Description This is a comprehensive self-paced online course developed by an expert, certified trainer to provide an introduction to ICD-10 CM coding. ICD-10-CM is the diagnosis code set that will be replacing ICD-9-CM Volumes 1 and 2. ICD-10-CM will be used to report diagnoses in all clinical settings. The implementation date for ICD-10 is **October 1, 2015**.

Note that *ICD-10-PCS* is the procedure code set that will be replacing ICD-9-CM Volume 3 and will be used to report hospital inpatient procedures only.

Course Summary This course will benefit coders, educators, billing staff and clinicians who are interested in familiarizing themselves with ICD-10-CM. Gain an understanding about the history, organization and structure, see how ICD-10-CM compares to ICD-9-CM, explore changes chapter by chapter, and learn coding conventions and guidelines.

More than 400 slides of important information have been incorporated to present a comprehensive introduction to ICD-10-CM.

A coding book is NOT NEEDED to take this course.

The course concludes with a 50-question self-assessment test to assess your practical knowledge of the skills reviewed. A passing score of 70% or higher is necessary to obtain 6 CEUs (see CE Credits in top tab for more details).
